Successfully chosen scholars will take part in 3 football training sessions a week, complete strength and conditioning plans, as well as represent Grimsby Town U19 shadow team in the EFL Community & Education Football Alliance (CEFA) playing other professional teams' U19 shadow squads.













On top of football, scholars will work towards achieving a Level 3 BTEC Extended Diploma in Sports Coaching. The course has no exams and is largely based on coursework and work based learning, using GTSETs links to coaching at grassroots level as a valuable work experience.

All training takes place at Franklin College Sixth Form, where you will get all the benefits of a Franklin student. All lessons take place at GTSETs Education Suite at Blundell Park.
